CERTIFICATE COLLECTION

If you are **attending** the graduation ceremony, you can collect your certificate on the day of graduation.

If you are a Higher Education Student:

A digital copy of your award will be issued to all Higher Education students following the ceremony. Please look out for an email from My eQuals. If you **do not** wish to attend the ceremony, Student Records will post your certificate, so please ensure your postal details are up to date.

If you are a VET student:

You will have already received your certificate digitally within 30 days of completing your course. Please keep an eye out for an email from noreply@myequals.net and follow the prompts to access your certificate.

If you **do not** wish to attend the ceremony, please follow the prompts in the My eQuals email to order a hard copy of your certificate. Once we receive your order, your certificate will be produced and posted to you.

Students must select 'graduate in absentia' on the Graduation Registration portal within the registration period from Wednesday 28 January 2026 9:00am to Wednesday 25 February 2026 5:00pm.

WHAT TO BRING

All graduands and guests are required to bring a digital or printed copy of their ticket. Tickets will be scanned at the entrance to the Graduation Hall.

Graduands are asked to keep belongings to a minimum as they will not be permitted in the Graduation Hall.

WHAT TO WEAR

A graduation ceremony is a formal occasion. We ask that you dress in 'formal wear' or 'business attire'.

WHERE TO GO

Upon arrival, please proceed to the Swanston Hall for graduand registration, gown collection and photography. Graduands are required to arrive between 10:00am and 12:00pm. This is to ensure enough time for gowing, check-in and photos. Please refer to ceremony timeline.

LATE ARRIVALS

All graduands are required to attend the ceremony briefing which is held 1 hour prior to the ceremony. Any late graduands will be excluded from the ceremony proceedings.

Please note that late arrivals will be excluded from attending this ceremony and no refunds will be issued.

CHECK-IN

Upon arrival at the Swanston Hall, you will be greeted by a member of staff for check-in. Please ensure you have your printed or digital ticket on hand.

GOWN COLLECTION

After check-in, a member of staff will direct you to gowing area. Staff will be available to assist you with gowing to ensure your regalia is positioned correctly.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Graduands will have one photo taken when you are receiving your award on stage, this is included in your ticket price and will be provided to you digitally

Once you have been fully gowned, you and your guests can proceed to take professional photography. Photography services will be available before and after the ceremony. Please note that preference will be given to those who have pre-booked their photography session through when registering.


